A Scout is...

Trustworthy

- Be accountable for what you say
 - Be where you are supposed to be when you said you would be there
 - Ex: Train station for departure
- Be responsible
 - Be polite in public
 - Pick up litter
 - Listen to authority

Loyal

- Follow the Buddy System
 - ALWAYS KNOW WHERE YOUR BUDDY IS!

Helpful

- Do your part
 - Cooking
 - Cleaning
 - Buying food

Friendly

- Respect the other campers in the area
 - No loud voices after a certain time (10:30-11)
 - No inappropriate language

Courteous

- Be respectful to park officials
- Be respectful to people in general
 - Fellow scouts
 - Parents
 - Leaders
 - Other campers
- No inappropriate language
- Use headphones if watching a video on the train
- Take your fair share of food, and come back for seconds ONLY when everyone else has gone through the line
- “If it’s not yours, don’t touch it.” - Mr. Jones

Kind

- No pranking
- “Do unto others as you would have them do unto you.” - The Golden Rule
- See above, ‘Helpful,’ ‘Friendly,’ ‘Courteous,’ ‘Kind’

Obedient

- Listen to the jurisdiction of supervising officers (Adults, SPL, Rangers, etc.)
- Follow the rules and regulations of all the places that we visit
- Follow the Outdoor Code
- LEAVE NO TRACE

Cheerful

- Keep an upbeat attitude, make Troop 16 look good
- “No whining!” - Mr. Jones

Thrifty

- Don’t be wasteful
- Don’t spend all your money at one place

Brave

- Be able to handle different scenarios
- Be prepared, have the necessary equipment

Clean

- Take frequent showers (daily)
- Washing your clothes
- Staying clean in language
 - No inappropriate language
- Clean up after yourself
 - Don’t make much of a mess in the first place
- LEAVE NO TRACE
 - Take only photos, leave only footprints
- Be careful with fires
 - “Only you can prevent wildfires.” - Smokey the Bear
 - Outdoor Code
- Do not litter
 - Use your pockets as temporary trashcans
 - Pick up litter, even if it’s not yours
 - Outdoor Code

Reverent (Respectful)

- Be respectful of the park and people in the parks
- Be respectful to the animals
 - Leave them alone!
